in Private Homes at the Beginning of the Reign of Nicholas I
as a Pedagogical and Personal Source**

Key words: foreign governesses; Ministry of national education; home education and upbringing; examination board of St. Petersburg University; documents of the Central state historical archive of St. Petersburg.

The article is devoted to the characteristic of the documents of the examination board of St. Petersburg University which provide a summary of applicants to receive a certificate entitling them to teach in private homes, as well as candidates who received it in the period from 1829 to 1834.

Home teachers were persons who had passed a special test at a university, a lyceum or a gymnasium. During such tests, it was necessary for the applicants to show general knowledge on the subjects that they had planned to teach. The process of receiving the appropriate documents was connected with the efforts of the government to supervise foreign governesses' activity. It is stressed in the article that only Sergei Uvarov, Minister of National Education in 1833–1849, managed to take control of home education in Russia.
